I have determined that there is probable cause to believe that _____ is removable from the United States. This determination is based upon:

the execution of a charging document to initiate removal proceedings against the subject;
 the pendency of ongoing removal proceedings against the subject;
 the failure to establish admissibility subsequent to deferred inspection;
 biometric confirmation of the subject's identity and a records check of federal databases that affirmatively indicate, by themselves or in addition to other reliable information, that the subject either lacks immigration status or notwithstanding such status is removable under U.S. immigration law; and/or
 statements made voluntarily by the subject to an immigration officer and/or other reliable evidence that affirmatively indicate the subject either lacks immigration status or notwithstanding such status is removable under U.S. immigration law.

- **Must Contain the Person's Name and Address**
- **If the name or address, is wrong warrant is invalid.**
- Pay attention to the **Signature Line: MUST have JUDGE'S Signature**

- This is a **Warrant for Arrest of Alien Issued by DHS/ICE**
- Pay attention to the **Signature Line. This is Signed by an Authorized Immigration Officer – NOT signed by a JUDGE!**
- **Therefore DON'T OPEN the DOOR!**
