Or are you currently enrolled and looking for financial assistance? **Episcopal Homes Foundation** is now accepting applications to the scholarship program for the fall 2021 semester. All staff are encouraged to apply!

We offer scholarships of up to \$5,000 for professional studies and up to \$10,000 per year for people pursing health professional degrees.

Foundation launches the Employee Emergency Assistance Program

Beginning **July 1, 2021**, Episcopal Homes Foundation will be launching the Employee Emergency Assistance program. This program is designed to support staff whose ability to get to work or perform their duties effectively while at work is hindered by a temporary financial crisis.

There are two forms of emergency assistance you can request:

- Emergency food, transit/fuel, or prescription support of up to \$100 per year.
- Emergency debt relief, such as to support medical, housing, or transportation emergencies of **up to \$750 per year**.

This program is supported by contributions from residents, families, staff, Episcopal Homes' business partners, and other community members. For this reason, not all requests can or will be approved.


